## WHITE WINES

**Grüner Veltliner Holzgasse 2006 (Austria) £10.50 (£3.00/£4.00)**

Animated flowery nose with fresh apples, citrus fruit, minerals and spices.

**Les Vignes Retrouvees Blanc, Cotes De Saint- Mont, 2005 (France) £12.90 (£3.50/£4.50)**

This is a deceptively complex wine that has delicious, crisp fruit with lovely balancing acidity.

**Long beach Chenin Blanc 2006 (South Africa) £10.50 (£3.00/£4.00)**

Light & Fresh with a floral bouquet

**Pencarrow Sauvignon Blanc 2004 (New Zealand) £17.00 (£5.00/£6.00)**

A beautiful, balanced expressive NZ Sauvignon. Green fruit & grass

**Chablis, Domaine Des Valery 2004 (France) £18.90 (£5.50/£6.50)**

Lovely pure mineral flavours and elegant, fruity style.

**Pinot Gris, Pfaffenheim 2004 (Alsace) £18.90**

Very well made, juicy with honeyed fruit, good weight and a dash of fresh, lemony acidity.

**Pinot blanc, Salwey 2004 (Germany) £18.90**

Classic Germanic wine with a steely dry palette.

**Chardonnay Finca La Florencia Cassone 2004 (Argentina) £14.00**

Rich Variatel flavours married with the back bone of French oak

**Pouilly Fume, Jean Pabiot, 2004 (France) £22.00**

Dry, refined and very fruity. Ideal with fish and poultry.

**7<sup>th</sup> Continent Chardonnay Pinot Grigio, 2005 (Australia) £15.00**

Bright, fresh and crisp. Unusual combination that drinks really well.

**Soave Classico, Vigna Ronchetto, 2004 (Italy) £18.90**

Cream crisp flavours with a background taste of almond blossom.

**Crawford River Reserve Riesling 2003 (Australia) £35.00**

Mineral and lime stone qualities with citrus and stone fruit.

**Macon Village, Guillemot- Michael 2004 (France) £26.00**

A deliciously layered flavour of melon and toast.

**Santenay 1er cru Clos du beauregard, Vincent Girardin, 2003 (France) £35.00**

Richly fruited with a lovely stoney, mineral elegance, this is a very classy wine.

**Puligny-Montrachet, Etienne Sauzet 2002 (France) £55.00**

A blend of parcels from all over the village, a little from the high slopes gives the minerality.

Lively, charming and fruity character

A round wine with fruit and elegance

Light, fruity & dry

## RED WINES

**Blauer Zweigelt 2004 (Austrian) £10.50 (£3.00/£4.00)**

Cherry red colour, fruit driven nose, with hints of spice

**Cuvee harmonie, Domaine La Condamine l'eveque, 2004 (France) £12.90 (£3.50/£4.50)**

Rich, charming fruitiness and sheer drink ability.

**Merlot Santa - Carolina 2004 (Chile) £12.90 (£3.50/£4.50)**

Soft plummy fruit with a touch of spice and well ingrained tannin

**Fleurie Domaine de la Viroylette, J Charlett 2004 (France) £20.90 (£6.00/7.00)**

A Light, soft fruity Beaujolais with a delicate style and distinctive raspberry qualities.

**Gustales Crianza, Rioja 2003 (Spain) £15.50 (£5.00/£6.00)**

Vanilla aromas and soft, jammy strawberry fruit dominate this wine.

**Palliser Pinot Noir, 2002 (New Zealand) £28.50**

Burgundian in style- maturing wonderfully and showing very well

**Chateau Suzaez, Rousset-les-Vignes Cotes du Rhone Villages, 2003 (France) £17.00**

This has lovely, ripe strawberry and plum fruit character and cherry beneath.

**Shiraz Voyager 2002 (Australia) £25.00**

A sublime equilibrium of classy fruit and well knit tannin

**Kopland Estate Zinfandel Cinsault 2002 (South Africa) £14.50**

A real blockbuster from Paarl- warm, spicy & ripe

**Chateau Montaguillon, Montagne-Saint-Emilion 2002 (France) £23.50**

Delicious supple red fruit character of plums, blackcurrents and cherries

**Sterling Vineyards Cabernet Sauvignon 2002 (USA) £22.00**

Classy Californian Cab. Juicy bramble & blackcurrent with a touch of oak

**Sesti Grangiovese, IGT Toscana, Castello di Argiano 2004 (Italy) £20.00**

A very appealing wine with soft red berry fruit flavours and well-balanced tannins.

**Givry 1er cru Clos Jus, Gerard Mouton 2003 (France) £25.00**

A delicious, sappy Pinot Noir fruit that it is a classic red burgundy.

**Saint-Aubin 1er cru Les Frionnes, Henri Prudhon 2003 (France) £30.50**

The palate is full of delicious red fruit which promises excellent current drinking.

**Chateau grand-Puy-Ducasse, 5me cru paulillac 1996 (France) £63.00**

A classic pauillac with cassis and damson fruit, cedar and pencil lead undertones.
